1. Meeting commenced at 7.35pm. Allowing for any latecomers. Chairman welcomed those present, including a visitor from Spain.
2. KC was thanked for organising the Luggie clean-up; there are now fewer tyres taking up residence! Other rubbish was also removed, and it has obviously been a big improvement. Lisa Giffen was also mentioned for providing food for those who volunteered to carry out the clean-up.
3. Community Councils throughout the area have had their grants reduced by 40%.
4. Tree obscuring the bus stop has again been noted and photographed by Cllr. MacDonald, who will be taking up this complaint. People have been missing buses on wet days if they are in the shelter as the drivers can't see them, and it's making it difficult to see the approaching buses.
5. Concerns were raised as to the validity of our insurance as it may not meet EU requirements. However, insurance is in place.
6. We believe the Horse's field may be at risk of being built on as developers are stating there aren't enough houses being built.
7. There has been no communication from the Association of Community Councils since January.
8. It was suggested that the minutes should be put on the website. There was some opposition to this idea for fear of personal details falling into the wrong hands, so this has been put on hold for the moment. However, highlights will be posted on the noticeboard prior to the meetings.
9. Craig Crescent Fence is now in the hands of the Council. Tenants have been asked for their opinions. It is no longer an issue for the Community Council.
10. A resident has been having difficulty when phoning the Council because it is sometimes difficult to understand him. Cllr. MacDonald has agreed to give him every assistance; hopefully this upsetting issue will be resolved very soon.
11. Cars parking on Bankhead Road making it dangerous especially on the corner was raised once more.
12. It was requested that a new seat be installed at the corner of Bankhead Road as the old one is beyond repair.

13. Another litter pick planned for the end of August [Now postponed as the village is so clean]. Further details will follow.
14. Archie's may be holding duck race next year and also an event with Bouncy Castles in Miners' Car Park. Further details to follow.
